Uniform & Grooming

- The full school uniform is to be worn at all times to and from school.
- Students are not to mix/match the uniform. The wearing of sports tops, tracksuit or the jersey is not to be worn with the normal school uniform.
- Students in Years 7 9 are expected to wear their blue school jumper. The softshell jacket is optional.
- Students in Years 10 –12 are expected to also wear the blazer in the designated winter season.
- Students may wear a plain white "Bonds" style singlet or t-shirt under their uniform. This garment is to be securely tucked in to the trousers, tracksuit, shorts and skirts and should not be visible.
- The sports uniform is to be worn on sport day and the designated day for PE practical classes.
- During winter the complete tracksuit is to be worn. The sports jersey is an optional item and
 can be worn for extra warmth under the tracksuit top during the colder months or on cooler
 days in the warmer months with the sports shorts. The jersey does not replace the tracksuit
 top.
- During Terms 1 and 4 the school cap/hat is to be worn at all times when students are in the open, at sport, on the front oval, during both recess and lunch times.
- During Terms 1 and 4 the cap/hat must be worn during outside lessons, PE and Agriculture as examples. For school Sport, students without the school cap/hat will be provided sunscreen and may attend a detention the following day.
- General Attire for Drama Performances (Costume Policy)
 On the day of your practical performances the following must be worn. Failure to adhere to these guidelines will result in you not performing on the day and therefore losing mark on your performance.

GIRLS: Black leggings OR pants, NO hipster pants are permitted. Black long sleeve shirt OR Short sleeve shirt, NO Singlet tops of any description are permitted.

BOYS: Black pants. Black T-shirt OR long sleeve shirt.

If another costume needs to be worn on the day of the performance the classroom teacher must see the costume before the performance to ensure it is appropriate.

 Acceptable Girl's jewellery – Watch, signet ring, maximum two sets of plain sleepers or studs (small). Earrings are to be worn in the lobe of the ear. No "spacers" or facial piercings are allowed.

HAIR STYLE AND GROOMING:

- Students are to keep their hair at a natural colour.
- No radical shaving or styling of hair is permitted (minimum number 4 in length cut).
- Boys will keep their hair at a neat and tidy length (length is to be not past the bottom of the collar.
- Boys will not be permitted to have radical hair styles eg mullet style.
- Boys are not permitted to wear earrings.
- Both boys and girls should have their hair neatly styled and clean.
- Girls with shoulder length hair and longer will need to have it tied back.
- Nail polish is not permitted and make-up may be worn discreetly.
- Boys must be clean shaven. Sideburns must not extend beyond the top of the earlobe.
- Facial piercings (nose, eyebrow, lip etc.) are unacceptable.
- Tattoos should not be visible.
