Purpose

To demonstrate pride in our school community.

Scope

The scope of this policy includes Year 7 through to Year 12 students attending St Joseph's High School, Aberdeen.

Responsibilities

Girls' Summer Uniform

Skirt	Tartan pleated skirt in summer weight polyester viscose fabric, below knee length.
Blouse Junior	Short sleeve peak front blouse in chambray blue polyester cotton fabric with tartan trim on sleeves and pocket, SJA embroidery on pocket in navy blue.
Blouse Senior	Short Sleeve peak front blouse in white oxford polyester cotton fabric with tartan trim on sleeves and pocket, SJA embroidery on pocket in navy blue.
Neck Tie	Button-on cross over tie in tartan
Shoes	Black, conventional leather school shoes (no jogger types, no buckles, no boots)
Socks	Short white up-n-downer sock with navy 6mm stripe on top edge of sock

Girls' Sport Uniform

Sport shorts	Sport shorts in navy blue microfibre with side pockets, right pocket with zip, contrast panels of sky blue/gold and white on left leg and SJA embroidered in gold.
Sport shirt	Polo shirt in sky blue with contrast panels of royal blue/gold white and navy with SJA embroidered in gold
Joggers	Proper athletic jogger style to be worn
Socks	Sports sock with SJA woven into side of sock with royal and gold stripes.
Swimsuit	One piece – racing style (no two-piece) Board shorts may be worn over one-piece swimsuit
Tracksuit	<p>Spray jacket in navy blue microfibre with gold bias on each side of panel. Pockets in side seams, contrast panels of sky blue/gold and white, SJA embroidery on left panel in gold, navy blue polyester cotton lacoste lining.</p> <p>Track pants in navy blue microfibre with side pockets, right pocket with zip, contrast panels of sky blue/gold and white on left leg and SJA embroidery in gold.</p>



Cap	Sports cap in royal blue with gold sandwich on brim and SJA embroidered onto front of cap in gold Bucket hat in royal blue and SJA embroidered onto front of hat in gold
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Girls' Winter Uniform

Skirt	Tartan pleated skirt in winter weight polyester viscose fabric, below knee length.
Blouse junior	Long sleeve peak front blouse in chambray blue polyester cotton fabric with tartan trim on pocket and SJA embroidery on pocket in navy blue. Neckline is 4cm (1 ½") higher than summer blouse
Blouse senior	Long sleeve peak front blouse in white oxford polyester cotton fabric with tartan trim on sleeves and pocket, SJA embroidery on pocket in navy blue. Neckline is 4cm (1 ½") higher than summer blouse
Neck tie	Woven polyester tie in navy blue with stripes above and below badge, stripes sky/white/sky
Blazer	Unisex blazer in navy blue polyester wool serge weave fabric with SJA embroidery on top pocket in sky blue
Jumper	Knitted pullover in junior navy wool nylon with SJA crest on left chest.
Shoes	Black conventional leather school shoes (no jogger types/buckles/platforms/boots)
Stockings	Navy (opaque) (no above knee, sock styles)

Boys' Summer Uniform

Shorts	Tailored shorts in melange grey polyester viscose fabric
Shirt Junior	Short sleeve shirt in chambray blue polyester cotton with side splits, tartan trim on pocket and SJA embroidery in navy blue
Shirt Senior	Short sleeve shirt in white oxford polyester cotton with side splits, tartan trim on pocket and SJA embroidery in navy blue.
Shoes	Black, conventional leather school shoes (no jogger types)
Socks	Knee high socks in navy/white marle

Boys' Sport Uniform

Sport shorts	Sport shorts in navy blue microfibre with side pockets, right pocket with zip, contrast panels of sky blue/gold and white on left leg and SJA embroidered in gold.
Sport shirt	Polo shirt in sky blue with contrast panels of royal blue/gold white and navy with SJA embroidered in gold
Joggers	Proper athletic jogger style to be worn
Socks	Sports sock with SJA woven into side of sock with royal and gold stripes.
Swimmers	Dark coloured 'Speedos' (worn under nylon sport shorts or board shorts)
Tracksuit	Spray jacket in navy blue microfibre with gold bias on each side of

Boys' Winter Uniform

Trousers	Tailored trousers in melange grey polyester viscose fabric
Shirt junior	Long sleeve shirt in chambray blue polyester cotton fabric with tartan trim on pocket and SJA embroidery in navy blue
Shirt senior	Long sleeve shirt in white oxford polyester cotton fabric with tartan trim on pocket and SJA embroidery in navy blue
Neck tie	Woven polyester tie in navy blue with stripes above and below badge, stripes sky/white/sky
Blazer	Unisex blazer in navy blue polyester wool serge weave fabric with SJA embroidery on top pocket in sky blue
Jumper/Vest	Knitted pullover in junior navy wool nylon with SJA crest on left chest.
Shoes	Black conventional leather school shoes (no jogger types)
Socks	Short grey socks

Step by Step

- The full school uniform is to be worn at all times to and from school.
- Students are not to mix/match the uniform. The wearing of sports tops, tracksuit or the two tone/stripe 'footy' style jersey is not to be worn with the normal school uniform.
- Students in Years 7 – 9 are expected to wear their blue school jumper. A blazer is optional.
- Students in Years 10 –12 are expected to also wear the blazer.
- Neither boys nor girls may wear any coloured garment under their school uniform.
- However, students may wear a plain white "Bonds" style singlet or t-shirt under their uniform. This garment is to be securely tucked into the trousers, tracksuit, shorts and skirts
- The sports uniform is to be worn on sport day and for practical subjects such as PE and Agriculture.
- During winter the complete tracksuit is to be worn, the 'footy' jersey does not replace the tracksuit top but is designed to be worn under the tracksuit top when conditions demand.
- The school cap/hat is to be worn at all times when students are in the open, at sport, the front oval, during both recess and lunch times.
- The cap/hat must be on during outside lessons, for example PE and Agriculture. During Sport students without the school cap/hat will not attend Sport and will report to Sports Detention.
- The wearing of a watch, a signet ring, one set of plain gold/silver sleepers, studs or euro balls is deemed acceptable. Earrings are to be worn only in the lobe of the ear.



- Students are to keep their hair at a natural colour.
- No radical shaving or styling of hair is permitted.
- Boys should endeavour to keep their hair at a neat and tidy length, above the collar and on the ears.
- Both boys and girls should have their hair neatly styled and clean.
- The use of hair gel is not encouraged.
- Girls with shoulder length hair and longer will need to have it tied back.
- Nail polish is not to be worn.
- Boys must be clean shaven. Sideburns may not be beyond the top of the earlobe.
